Bye Rules:

- All Qs & qualifying events must be from the same dog & handler partnership who will be entered at the WCO.
- All Qs for Byes must be at the same jump height entered at the WCO Open except if moving from a Regular jump height to the Select height. Not moving from a regular height to another regular height or a select height to another select height.
- Regular titling Qs are not restricted to country competing in.
- Home Video Qs may be used but are only worth ½ of a regular Q. Therefore 2 Home Video Qs must be obtained to = 1 regular Q.
- Regular Qs & byes from Masters heats cannot be used more than once to count towards a bye. If attempting to qualify for byes at other events such as the US Open or the Canadian Open, additional Qs must be gained for those other events. These will be checked against previously submitted byes.
- Any clear round from any country's tournament classes from Masters, Biathlon, Pentathlon, Games Challenge, Speedstakes Challenge and I.C.E can be used to count as a regular Q.
- Runs from the US Open, Canadian Open, West Coast Open & 1-TDC Invitational cannot be used for regular Qs.
- Byes gained from US Cups, US Classics & US Festivals only count towards WCO Open Byes. (Canadian tournaments only count towards Canadian Open byes).
- Only byes submitted by the deadline listed in the premium will be honored.
